

Over-coming the existing famine, The proclamation states that the new government "relies for support on all classes which treasure the above objects. In particular, it expects to de-fend the north with the friendly assistance to Russia of governments and peoples of America, England, France and others. It also counts on allied assistance against starvation and fi-nancial difficulties."

The proclamation is signed by several members of the constitutent assembly from the northern region and by the assistant mayor of the city of Vologda and the vice-president of the Archangel city duma. forming the supreme govern ment of the northern territory.
