BILLY SUNDAY WILL SPEAK AT ARMORY SUNDAY-AFTERNOON

Gives His Services Free For Purpose of Aiding Salvation Army.

Billy Sunday, the famous evangelist who can handle the English language including the latest slang more skillfully than any revivalist in the country will speak next Sunday afternoon at the armory in Salem for the Salvation army.

The drive of the Salvation army to secure funds will begin about Sept. 15 and as sort of a preliminary, Billy Sunday, who is now resting on his laurels near Hood River, was invited by Governor Withycombe to speak in Salem. In accepting the invitation Sunday wrote as follows:

"Dear Governor: I wired you I would come to Salem for an address to aid the Salvation army in their drive for war activity funds. I do not feel strong enough to speak at Eugene also, as I am recovering from a severe operation and Mrs. Mayo insisted that I rest this summer.

"I will speak Sunday afternoon, 25th at 1:30 or 2 o'clock so I can reach Portland in time to take the 7 o'clock train for Hood River. I would like a pulpit 32 or 34 inches high as my eyes are not as good as they used to be and I have only an outline of my address which I will follow.

"I make no charges for my help. I am delighted to render this service and all I ask is expenses. Whether you charge admission or admit people free and then take an offering or pledges, that is optional with your committee.

"If all this is satisfactory, you may call it settled for August 25. Mr. E. O. Hummel of Eugene Council of Defense asked me to come to Eugene but I vetoed. I was afraid the strain would be too much. I am pleased at the record dear old Oregon is making for liberty and justice. The Lord bless you."

"P. S. Mrs. Sunday and perhaps our two boys will be with me."

White Soldiers and Negroes Have Clash Six Reported Killed

Hoboken, N. J., Aug. 19.—Major General Shanks, commanding the United States port of embarkation, today was conducting an investigation into a race riot Saturday night at Camp Merritt, N. J., near Teanah, which is believed unofficially to have caused the deaths of six soldiers—five negroes and a white man. Several are in the hospital at Camp Merritt suffering from wounds, mainly bayonet thrusts.

The riot developed, it was said by soldiers from the camp when a negro soldier from Texas, attempted to sit at a table where white soldiers from Mississippi were writing letters. A fist fight followed and both black and white soldiers were soon mixing it.

Two negroes and a white man were dead, say unofficial reports, when the military police and a company of soldiers cleared the Y. M. C. A. but the others are believed to have died later.
