Court House Notes

In order to acquire the riparian rights of Mrs. Jennie Hall to the water flowing from Green Springs, the city of Turner has brought suit against Mrs. Hall. The city acknowledges her riparian rights and for that reason asks the court for a jury to establish their value. In a recent trial before the circuit court, Mrs. Hall won in her suit against the city of Turner and the city must now buy the right of Green Springs or secure them by condemnation proceedings.

In the divorce suit of Irene Nash against Herbert Nash, the defendant filed his answer claiming that his wife had been insulting and abusing him and attempting to drive him away from home. Also that she has refused to wait upon or care for him or cook, or make his beds or in any manner recognize him as her husband. Also that in the scraps they have had, he was only defending himself. They live at 1396 Fir street.

In the suit of Beulah R. Rateliff against Levi D. Rateliff and his daughter, Nellie Pearl Rateliff, the circuit court finds that the plaintiff is entitled to a decree dissolving the bonds of matrimony and that she shall be paid the sum of \$1000 by the defendant. Also that the deed from the plaintiff and defendant to Nellie Pearl Rateliff for lots 1 and 2, block 22, Highland addition be set aside. Their troubles from a real estate point of view came when about two years ago Mr. Rateliff was sick and expected to die and under the circumstances Mrs. Rateliff was induced to sign her name in the deed of certain property. Mr. Rateliff did not die and the court was called on to settle matters.

In the county court an order was issued naming Jan. 27, 1919, as the date for the final hearing in the matter of the estate of Anna Qualley, George W. Hubbs is executor of the estate.
