SPARTACANS GIVING UP HEAD AT LICHTENBERG

War Minister Noske Says That Unconditional Surrender Are Only Terms.

LATER IT IS REPORTED THAT HE HAS RESIGNED

Rebels Appealed Unsuccessfully For Withdrawal Of Government Troops.

Amsterdam, March 13.—Dispatches received here today said that Spartacans caught between two fires were evacuating their positions in Lichtenberg. The burgo-master is said to have appealed unsuccessfully to War Minister Noske to draw off his troops and replace them with a "people's guard," including Spartacans.

Unconditional Surrender.

London, March 13.—A wireless dispatch received from Berlin today reported that War Minister Noske replying to a request by the Spartacans for armistice terms, said the only terms would be "unconditional surrender, including all arms."

Noske Resigned.

Zurich, March 13.—War Minister Noske resigned Tuesday morning, it was reported in a dispatch from Berlin today. General Von Lequis is said to have succeeded him.

Fighting Continued.

Berlin, March 13.—Fighting was continuing in Berlin tonight over a front of more than twenty five kilometers (15 and a half miles).
