### BOY SCOUTS TO OPEN CAMPAIGN FOR FUNDS

Tag Sale Method To Be Used In Drive Set To Open On Saturday.

The Boy Scouts of America of the local troops will canvass the city tomorrow in a tag sale drive in an attempt to raise \$1500 of the \$3000 budget that was voted at a recent meeting of the council. The finance committee of the

council has undertaken the raising of half of the budget and the boys have volunteered to raise the balance. The tags will sell for not less than \$1, although it is expected that many who have not yet had the chance to contribute to this work will give more. The money raised by this budget will be spent in this city in the establishing of a Scout headquarters and the employment of an executive to give his time to the direction of the work, the establishing of a summer camp at Walden Lake for the boys of this city, and the outfitting of a local fire and drum corps, besides the many minor items that come forth in the expenses of the broadening of the work in this city.
