F. N. Derby, receiver of the Independent Mint Market, reports that Berkenwald & Co., of Portland, claimed the Fairbanks scales and two metal blocks of the market, sold on contract, and that P. W. Reynolds claimed one marble top counter. The rest of the personal property of the market he sold at auction for \$406.34, and this with the \$127.89 in bank, made total receipts of \$534.23. The expenses of the receiver's office amounted to \$131.59. Of this amount, \$95 was for attorney's fees and \$35 for the receiver. There is now in the hands of the receiver \$402.73. If too many claims do not come in, it is thought that the receiver may be able to pay all claims about 35 cents on the dollar.
