Henry Ford, Not Local Men, To Blame For Vick's Moving
It is understood that a few gronches who are inclined to criticize everything, have been making some unfavorable comments on the Salem Commercial club for permitting the whole business of Vick's Bros. to move to Portland.
In this instance, according to George Vick, it is Henry Ford who is doing the moving and not any of the Vick brothers. When Mr. Vick was in Detroit a few months ago, he was plainly told by Mr. Ford that the state agency for the Fordson tractor should be in a larger city and Mr. Vick was given to understand at the time that if he remained the agency for the tractor, he would have to move to Portland.
As a distributing point, Henry Ford insisted on the tractors being handled from the larger city, especially as Vick Bros. had been given the wholesale agency for southern Idaho in connection to the state of Oregon.
In speaking of the business change, Mr. Vick said this morning: "We received more than we can express, the necessity of having our business and our friends in Salem. Our business has been built up here and within the past two years, two of us have built homes and expected to make Salem our permanent home."
"Mr. Ford put it up to us indirectly that the wholesale agency must be located in Portland. There is nothing that we could do, or anything the Salem Commercial club could do to change Henry Ford's mind on this subject."
Died
MARIELS—At Portland, Oregon, April 10, 1919, Clarence W. Mariels, at the age of 48 years.
He is survived by six children, Herbert, Percy, Clarence, Jessie, Lyle, Emma and Eugene Mariels, all of Salem. He is also survived by two brothers, John Mariels of Portland and Fred Mariels of Lyons, Oregon, and two step-daughters, Miss Lillian Gill and Mrs. Ida Keyes, both of Salem.
Clarence W. Mariels was born May 27, 1871, at Mason City, Missouri, and moved to Oregon when 14 years old. Since his coming to Oregon he had always lived in Salem or vicinity.
Several years after the death of his first wife, he married Miss Emma Holt in 1917, who also survives to mourn his loss.
He was converted to the Apostolic faith three weeks before his death. Burial was at Fox Valley, Oregon.
