In 1916 this crop in the north-west was 42,000,000 pounds. In 1917 it was 23,000,000. But last year the record crop brought the production of orunes in this parthwest territory up to the highest price ever known. Hence the prosperity of prune growers

Acording to the present market, there another year assured of prosperity to he prane growers, provided nothing happens at this critical time of year. By some, it is thought that the total op will not run to the high figures of one year zgo. Packers who are selling on the future market are taking me chances on a large crop.

There is a feeling among those in lose touch with the prune situation but the present prices are most unusual and there is no assurance they will be maintained. But millions of people tasted for the first time the finest prunes ever grown. They came from Oregon and there is now an unusual nand for the Oregon prune.
