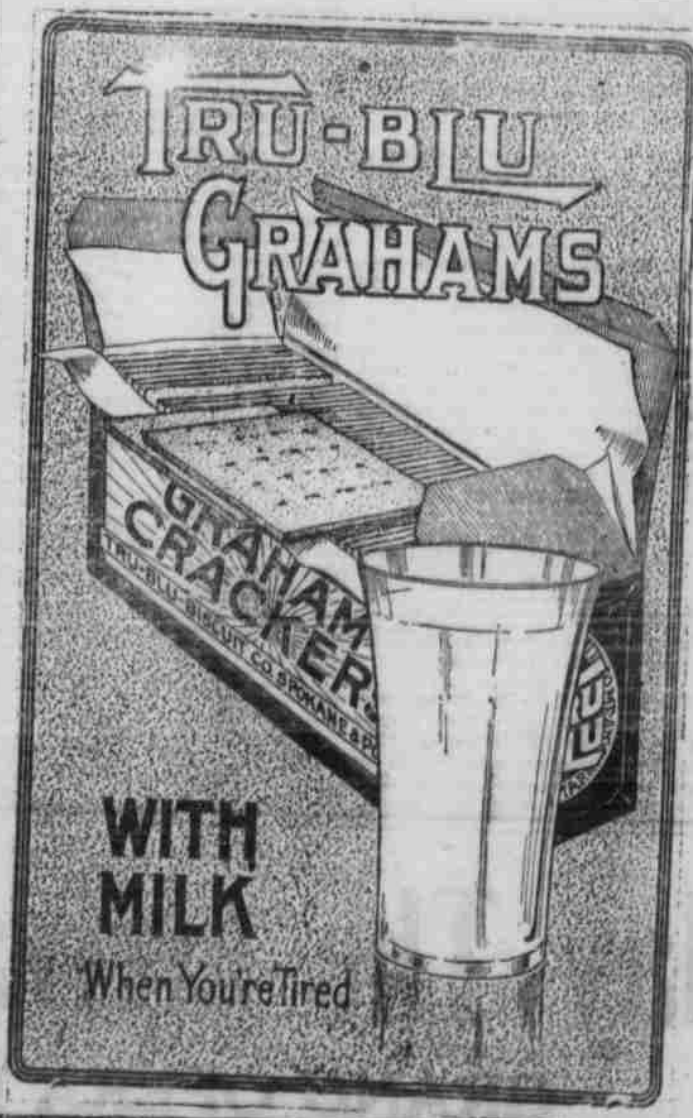

London, May 2.—(United Press.)—A news agency dispatch from Spalato, dated April 29 and relayed by way of Copenhagen reported that Italian forces and way material have landed at Seara and Sebenico. Their troops were said to be marching eastward from those cities and reinforcements were marching toward the line of demarcation. Seara is on the Dalmatian coast, 20 miles southeast of Fiume. Sebenico is 45 miles southeast of Seara.
