"I have always said anywhere suits me," Willard went on. "Toledo or Turkey, anywhere's all right."

"We can do a lot of fighting in a dozen rounds. We should have no difficulty in settling who's the better man in a 12 round battle."

Willard is here staging a movie. He spends the better part of each day out on the "lot" at the studios, surrounded by a picturesque lot of cowboys and "atmosphere."

It will take about two weeks longer for him to complete his picture. He will then leave for the middle west.

Willard has three sparring partners—all sizeable gentlemen—with him and works out with them daily.

Willamette Nine Blanks High School Aggregation

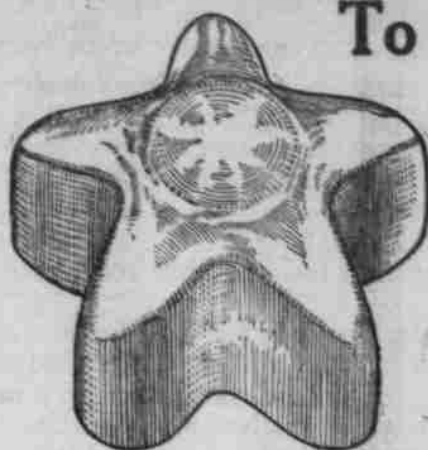

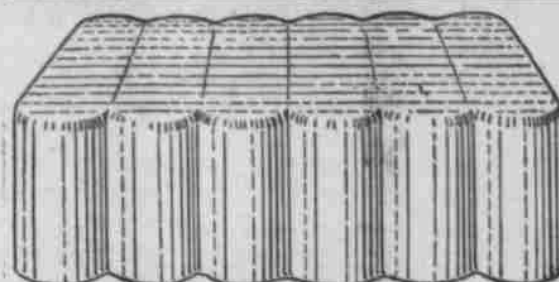

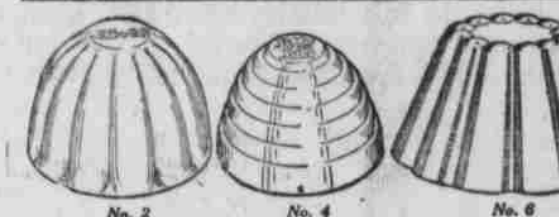

Peoples' Chorus Votes To Postpone Rehearsals Until Fall At Monday Meeting

At the business meeting of the Peoples' Chorus last night the matter of electing officers for the coming year was summarily disposed of by authorizing the secretary, Benj. F. West, to cast a vote for the re-election of the present officers, the general opinion being that it is good policy "hang onto a good thing." Considerable time was given to the discussion of matters of policy in carrying on the musical work. Among other things it was suggested that a larger membership might be maintained if a more central location was secured for the practice room. Various places were suggested in the business section, but the matter was finally left to a committee of three.

The report of the secretary showed that there were quite a number of members who were still in arrears in the payment of dues for music and the request was made that these immediately make payment to the secretary in order to balance up the books for the year.

Following the reading of the report, the president, Mrs. Clark, called attention to the regrettable fact that the attendance of members was becoming "increasingly small and beautifully less" on account of the great number of church, school and public affairs that are in process of preparation and to be staged within the next few weeks. Some

of the members are involved in several of these events simultaneously so that it is impossible for them to keep up the practice with the chorus.

Director Sites supplemented her statement by reading a list of a dozen or more musical and other programs that were under way in the city and which

made continual demands upon our musical talent. In view of this it was suggested that the presentation of the oratorio, "The Creation," be postponed until fall when it could be carried through with an open field and a full chorus. This suggestion was accepted by unanimous vote, and the rehearsals will be

abandoned for the summer. In adjourning the Chorus, an expression of hearty appreciation was made of the work of Director Sites in training the voices; and a vote of thanks was also extended to the university authorities for the use of Waller hall as a practice room.
