Two Unusual Wills Filed With County Clerk Today

Under ordinary circumstances, a will and last testament is filed for record after the death of the maker of the will. But in some instances, a will is filed for record in the office of the county recorder during the lifetime of the maker, in order to prevent any possibility of the will becoming lost.

Two wills were filed yesterday in the office of the county recorder just as a matter of security. The will of Chas. M. Phillips is rather unusual from the fact that within five minutes after the will was filed, a deed of transfer was made conveying the same property.

On Nov. 23, 1915, Mr. Phillips of Scotts Mills, directs in his will that lot 3 and the north half of lot 4, and lots 15 and 16 in block 25 of the town of Scotts Mills, be the property of his wife as a life interest, and that after her death, be equally divided among his children. The will was filed for record at 9:40 o'clock on the morning of May 13, 1919. Five minutes later there was filed for record a deed to exactly the same lots, conveying the property to his wife.

The second will filed this morning differed from the usual was that of Michael Reimer of Mt. Angel. After directing that his debts and funeral expenses be paid, he willed his estate as follows:

"To Father Dominic, pastor of St. Mary's parish of Mt. Angel, the sum of \$500 to be used by him or his successor in St. Mary's parish of Mt. Angel for the purpose of saying masses for me.

"To the pastor of St. Joseph's Roman Catholic church at Dodham, Iowa \$200 to be given to said church as a donation from me.

"To the pastor of the Roman Catholic church at Marion South Dakota, \$200 to be given as a donation from me.

"To my daughter Zora Barth of Los Angeles, \$500 in cash.

"To my daughter Teresa Reimer of Los Angeles, \$250 cash.

"To my daughter Anna Ahn of Council Bluffs, Iowa, \$500 cash.

"To my niece Louisa Ellstrand of Omaha, Neb. \$500 cash.

"To Joseph
