Irrigation for 1919—The system of dividing the city into two districts which proved so satisfactory last year will be continued for the season of 1919.
The houses which bear even numbers on the streets will irrigate only on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday, and the houses which bear odd numbers on the streets irrigate only on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. This plan will permit every house to irrigate four days out of each week.
By strictly following this rule we are able to supply our patrons with the usual amount of water under more satisfactory conditions. Season irrigation bills will be discounted 10 per cent if paid on or before June 10th.—Salem Water, Light & Power Co. 6-10
