State House Notes The Highway Commission has taken steps to eliminate and relocate the stretch of road running from the Hawley Paper Mills at Oregon City to Canby, as it is considered a dangerous bit of highway on account of the Oregon Electric tracks which occupy the middle of the road. You Can Always Do Better At MEYERS GOOD GOODS. As the result of an investigation and hearing by the Public Service Commission, the Southern Pacific company will be required to build a spur line from its main track to a packing plant at Woodburn. The Commission holds that as the proposed plant will serve a large community of people the spur will be of sufficient importance to be designated as a public utility. The Fish and Game Commission, in response to numerous inquiries as to the open season for elk, calls attention to the fact that there will be no open season for this animal, as the law enacted in 1917, repealing the law of 1909, provides for perpetual protection. The projected St. Johns bank, which was headed off by the action of the Superintendent of Banks in refusing to grant a charter, is again brought to notice by the filing of a demurrer by Attorney General Brown to the mandamus proceedings by which the governor of the bank sought to compel the superintendent to issue a charter. The demurrer is based upon the contention that the circuit has no jurisdiction over the action of the state banking board.
