Dr. B. H. White Answers Charges Of Wife's Suits

In the suit of Edith Eyre White versus Dr. B. H. White for the return of property to her which had been decided to them as tenants by the entirety, Dr. White has filed his answer as follows:

That at the time of their marriage in 1906, he was possessed of personal property to the value of \$2000 and that his income from his practice was \$2000 over and above his expenses. That shortly after his marriage, he ascertained that the plaintiff was possessed of property worth from \$10,000 to \$15,000.

That in 1907 both agreed to speculate in unimproved lands in South Dakota and according to this agreement, they borrowed on their joint note \$2000 and finally bought farm land in South Dakota with the title made out to both, as tenants in the entirety. Also that his wife acquired in this arrangement.

That they still own two quarter sections of this land and that the legal effect of this joint ownership had been discussed between them and that she had agreed to it.

That in 1910 they jointly bought land in Idaho to the value of \$2,000 and had jointly borrowed money for the purchase.

That their home bought in Salem in 1907 was taken with the title to both and that it was understood that it should be so. That she had repeatedly assured him that it was her wish that the title to the home should be held by both as tenants in common.

Dr. White also alleges that at all times his wife had access to the records, that she had examined the deeds and that she had all information regarding the transfers.

It was upon his wife's repeated request, Dr. White alleges, that he had given up his practice to take trips for her pleasure and health, to the detriment of his practice. That he had consented to make these trips, to the injury of his practice, with the express understanding that their real estate interests were of a joint nature, and with the understanding that if she died first he was to have the home property as well as her other real estate holdings.

This it was understood, Dr. White alleges, was in the way of compensation for interference with his professional income and expenditures of earnings from his practice, in living in a mode of life beyond his means.

Two suits have been filed by Edith Eyre White against her husband. One for the return of property held by them as tenants in the entirety, and the other for a divorce. No date for trial has been set for either of the suits.
