**FRUIT QUARANTINE
FORCES ARE MERGED**

Ghas. A. Park Tells of Progress Made At Recent Riverside Meeting.

Commissioner Chas. A. Park, of the State of Horticulture, returned recently from a most important gathering of fruit organizations held in the city of Riverside, California, and which called together 300 representatives from all parts of the West, Mexico, Hawaii and British Columbia. In the convention were the heads of fruit and vegetable associations, horticultural commissioners and noted entomologists. Out of this conference was organized two important organizations—the Western Plant Quarantine Board and the Western Plant Protective Association.

While the gathering discussed more or less all the problems before the fruit growers, the grand object of the convention was to co-ordinate the various quarantine activities in order to secure more effective regulations in every state. Mr. Park noted that heretofore there has been more or less friction in the matter of commerce in nursery and agricultural products among the states. All the states have suffered greatly from the depredations of introduced pests, and the strongest efforts have been made by quarantine officers to prevent the introduction of still more. This very vigilance has led to charges of discrimination from shippers who have innocently suffered loss and hardship. Thus the object is to further the campaign at large among the western states against menacing pests.

The second organization, the Western Plant Protective Association, in a sense overlaps the work of the other, but has no police power. Its object is to further the campaign at large among the western states against menacing pests. They will make a specialty of combating the oil-worm in potatoes, and the white pine blister rust, which has been introduced into the east from Europe and is now on its way across the continent. The particular hosts of this pest are the five-leaf pine, the currant and gooseberry. Prof. H. P. Barnes, of the Oregon Agricultural College, was made president of this organization.

Emphasizing the danger of the oil-worm, Commissioner Park cited the case of a carload of seed potatoes shipped all the way from Los Angeles to be planted on the rich reclaimed lands about Lake Labish. On inspection by the quarantine officers the potatoes were found to be infected with oil-worm disease, which if intro-

duced into the soil is impossible to eradicate. It will not only enter the tubers but any other vegetable grown upon that soil, and it may be carried from one locality to another by the dirt on horses' hoofs. This car of potatoes was promptly shipped out of the state.

**OLCOTT IS REGULAR
AIR ENTHUSIAST NOW**

Governor, Nervous Before Flight, Says Experience Wonderful.

Governor Olcott returned over the Southern Pacific from his "air invasion" of California this morning at 6 o'clock, went directly to bed for a "cat nap" and a few hours later was back in his office receiving congratulations and answering multifarious questions. Apparently he is no worse for the experience, and has become an enthusiast in the matter of air transportation.

In the course of an interview he said:

"It has been a wonderful trip, and it is difficult to find words to describe it. I confess that before I took my seat in the plane for the first time I was not at all enthusiastic over the prospect; but having taken it, I can say that I wouldn't have missed it for anything in the world. No, I had no really disagreeable sensations, even in the first flight from Salem. My pilot, Colonel Watson, took the air with an unusually long rise in order to avoid any jolt, and it was nothing more than the rapid lift of an elevator or the movement of an automobile on the pavement. Once up in the air, I experienced no feeling of nausea, though my pilot stated that passengers were often affected with seasickness—with disagreeable results to the man in front."

"There is none of the feeling of guidance one feels when looking over a cliff, but a sense of perfect security. The view of the valley from a height of several thousand feet was magnificent indeed. For a large part of the time we followed the course of the Willamette, which at that height looks like a band of silver laid out artificially on the green background.

Colonel Watson is a skilled pilot and made a practice of hopping over or dodging around clouds that had rain in them. Only once were we balked by a cloud mass, and that was in passing over the Cow Creek canyon country in Douglas county. It was too high to climb over and too big to get around, and Colonel Watson turned back northward until we recognized the opening of the canyon, which we followed on our way to Grants Pass.

"At Roseburg, Grants Pass and Ashland we were greeted by thousands. The people were fairly armed with their cameras and couldn't have kept them away from the machines with a gatling gun. I was called up on for brief addresses at all points.

"At Roseburg my pilot took me through a series of stunts, including the loop. This is done so quickly that one hasn't time to realize what has happened to him. It is virtually a perpendicular drop from a height of several thousand feet and when you reach the bottom of the loop and recover it seems as though you had struck the earth.

"The report that we attained a height of 15,000 feet is going over.
