STATE HOUSE NEWS The Washington state fair board has sent to Governor Orvick an invitation to join with them as the guest of Governor Hart in the observance of "governor's day" at the fair, which will occur on Sept. 18. Commissioner Kirk, who has been especially interested in the development of system and efficiency since he became connected with the industrial accident commission, states that arrangements have just been made for the standardization of the old clerical force in the matter of salary, so that all employees engaged in similar lines of work will have the same rate of salary. In addition to this, provision has been made for a general advance in salaries in order to place the department on the same plane as other lines of clerical service. Under the new schedule those employees who have been receiving a salary of less than a hundred dollars per month will be raised 10 per cent, while those who have been receiving more than a hundred dollars will receive a 5 per cent advance. As a further incentive to efficiency, a definite system of progressive promotion has been instituted, so that in

COURT HOUSE NEWS In the case of Silas Maley against Rose O'Connor now Rose Wilcox, the circuit court confirmed the sale by the sheriff of five lots in Newport. Robert McGilchrist has filed suit for a divorce from Belle L. McGilchrist. He alleges they were married in 1900 and that they have no children. Besides alleging cruel and inhuman treatment, he claims she said she "didn't give a whoop" for her husband. He also alleges that he had three children by a former wife but that his present wife did not like them. They own in common lot 7 of Sunny-side fruit farms, 19 acres. He asks for a division of the property according to law and a divorce. D. D. Roberts has brought suit against John Christy, alleging there is \$24 due and unpaid him for labor. He says that he worked 37 hours with a team between July 6 and July 12 and that he was to get \$1 an hour. The work was in lumber on the Adolph Jotta place near Champion. of Salem valued at \$3000. This is the vacant lot on Perry and High streets, just across the street from the frame buildings of the Hughes estate. D. H. Mosher has been appointed administrator of the estate of Sarah S. Mosher, deceased. The estate includes three lots in Salem on 8th Liberty street near Hood. The estate is valued at \$1700. For the benefit of employees coming under the provisions of the compensation act, the industrial accident commission calls attention to the fact that there is an established fee schedule provided by the commission for physicians who may be called in to attend accident cases, and in making compensation to the workman the physician's charges are expected to conform to this schedule. Some instances, however, have come to the notice of the commission where physicians have been paid directly by the victim and have made charges far in excess of the rate established by the commission. Employees are therefore warned to send all such bills to the commission for auditing. State Engineer Copper has just received application for the approval of drainage district No. 7, in Washington county, lying in the vicinity of Hillsboro. They propose to construct a drainage ditch to cost from \$30,000 to \$40,000, draining surface water into Dairy creek. The engineer's office has also been requested, through the state board of health, for a water supply for the city of Yamhill, where it is proposed to divert the waters of Turner creek through an 8 inch pipe for a distance of 8 miles. They also propose to construct a concrete reservoir to contain 350,000 gallons, estimated to cost \$47,000. According to the state of R. F. Jones of Lincoln county and Charles Hall of Coos county, two of the commissioners who were sent to Washington to seek congressional aid for the Roosevelt highway, there is no disposition on the part of the coast counties to have the governor call a special session of the legislature for the purpose of linking with the highway measure. The Roosevelt Highway association is well satisfied with the bill, they claim, but there are hints that certain highway enthusiasts want to join with the woman suffragists in the proposed special session in order to amend the act by eliminating the maintenance clause.
