Reservations Needed To Make Clear Viewpoint Of American People, Claim

Washington, Aug. 27.—Necessity for League of nations reservations "to make plain the American viewpoint" was urged today by Representative Slomp, Virginia and Echols, West Virginia, who have just returned from Europe.

"France apparently accepted the league in exchange for other more desirable features of the peace treaty," Echols said, "and apparently has little faith in the plan."

"All European countries are zealously looking after their interests with no thought of the United States," Slomp said, "and it is time that we limit our world views and safeguard our own interests. I found generally an indifference to the league of nations as finally worked out."
