NOTICE OF REVIEW AND EQUALIZATION OF ASSESSMENT ROLL

The State Tax Commission will act as a board of equalization at the capital in Salem, Oregon, on the third Monday in October, 1919, and will examine the assessment roll by it made, and review the same, and correct all errors in valuation, description, quantities or qualities of property by it assessable and in appointments of assessors made by it; and it shall be the duty of the persons and companies interested to appear at the time and place appointed.

Petitions or applications for the reduction or change of appointment of a particular assessor shall be made in writing, verified by the oath of the applicant, its president, secretary, manager or agent or attorney in fact, and be filed with the commission during the first week it is by law required to be in session, and any petition or application not so made, verified and filed shall not be considered or acted upon by the commission.
